Due to the early stage of project development, the session will not include information about specific procurements. The Site C project requires environmental certification and other regulatory permits and approvals before it can proceed to construction. In addition, the Crown has a duty to consult and, where appropriate, accommodate Aboriginal groups.

About Site C

BC Hydro's Site C Clean Energy Project is a proposed third dam and hydroelectric generating station on the Peace River in northeast B.C. It would provide up to 1,100 megawatts (MW) of capacity, and produce about 5,100 gigawatt hours (GWh) of electricity each year. The project is estimated to create approximately 7,000 person-years of direct construction employment through the seven-year construction period, and approximately 35,000 direct and indirect jobs through all stages of development and construction.
